The UOC extends its e-learning model to the Middle East with a project in Jordan

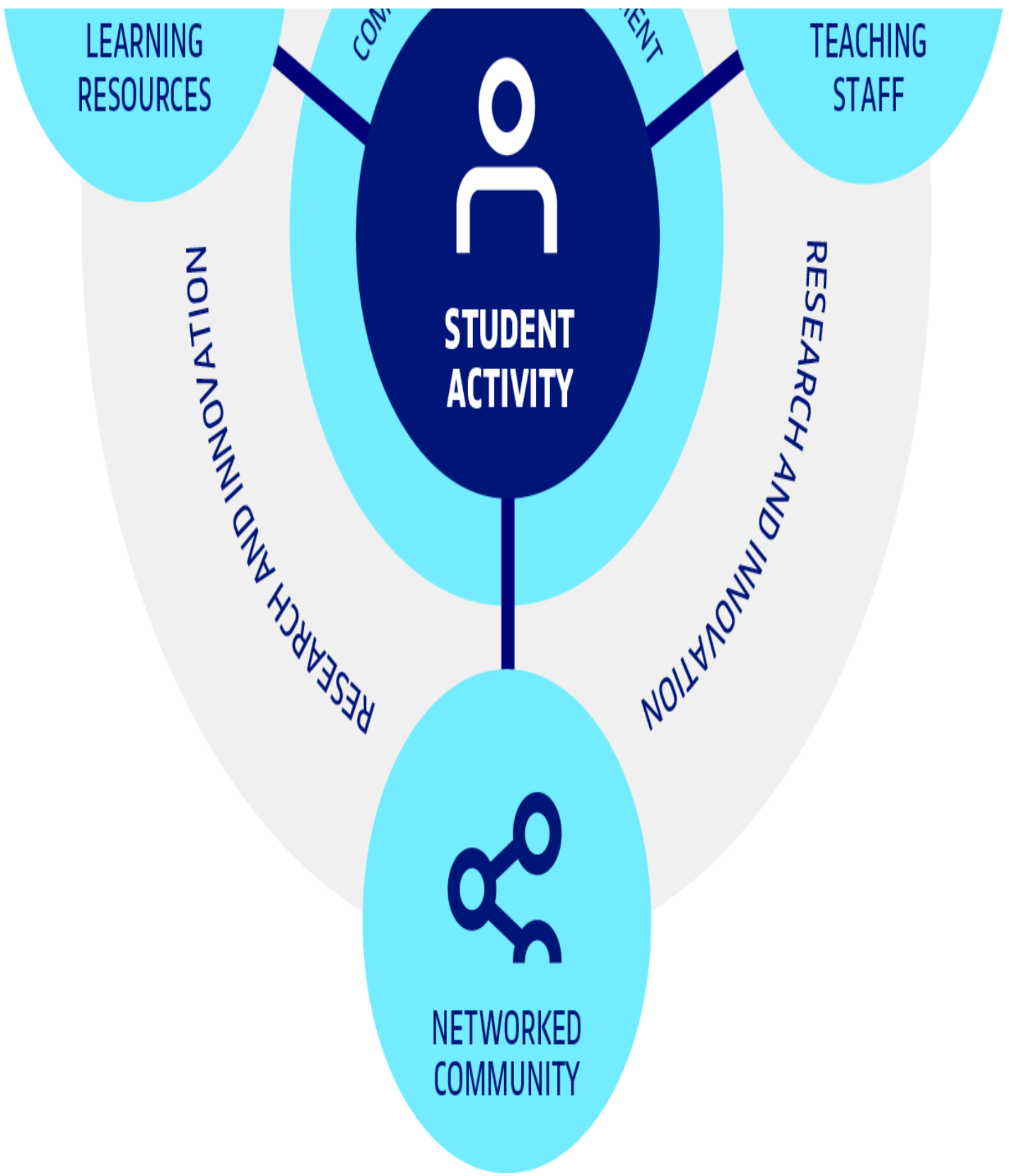

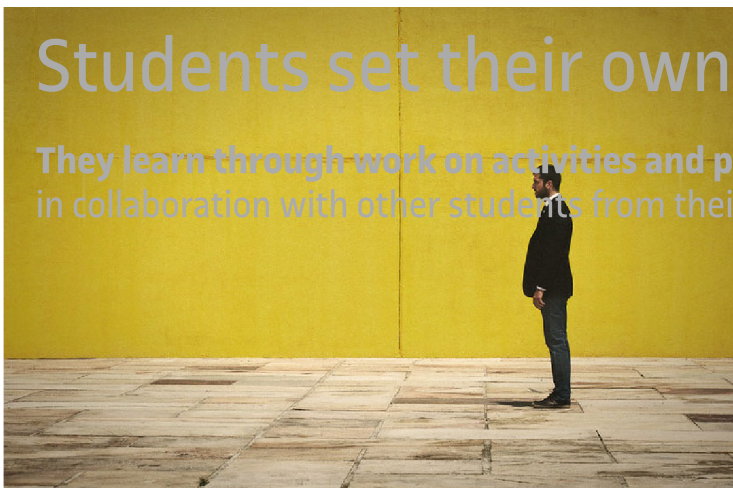
Teaching takes place in online classrooms and involves competency-based assessment
