

Students, faculty and staff are responsible for their visits and will be held financially responsible for citations issued to them.

- Students living in Alternative Housing (juniors, seniors, Cobbs, and Popp) will be issued an Alternative Housing permit that will allow them to park in the residence halls.
- Residential students may ONLY park in lots or spaces assigned to their permits, including the following lots: North and South Apartment lots, East Apartments, Main Lot, the row closest to English Hall, and North Lot. Residential Students may not park in Alternative Housing lots.
- Students with any unpaid citations will have a hold placed upon their account and will be unable to access grades and transcripts, and will be unable to register for classes.
- Students, faculty and staff are responsible for their visits and will be held financially responsible for citations issued to them.

Citations may be appealed for review by the Director of Public Safety if the contention is that the cited regulations were not violated. This is the only appropriate basis for an appeal. Appeals must be made in writing to the Director of Public Safety within fourteen (14) days of the date of the citation. Forms are available in the Public Safety office, guiford.edu or Guilford's intranet. Telephone and email appeals will not be accepted.

2. Citations may be appealed for review by the Director of Public Safety if the contention is that the cited regulations were not violated. This is the only appropriate basis for an appeal. Appeals must be made in writing to the Director of Public Safety within fourteen (14) days of the date of the citation. Forms are available in the Public Safety office, guiford.edu or Guilford's intranet. Telephone and email appeals will not be accepted.

3. Students with any unpaid citations will have a hold placed upon their performance of his/her duties-- which is a detriment or safety concern to the community.

4. Citations may be appealed for review by the Director of Public Safety if the contention is that the cited regulations were not violated. This is the only appropriate basis for an appeal. Appeals must be made in writing to the Director of Public Safety within fourteen (14) days of the date of the citation. Forms are available in the Public Safety office, guiford.edu or Guilford's intranet. Telephone and email appeals will not be accepted.

Towing and Wheel Boot Policy

- Any Public Safety officer may order the towing or immobilization of a vehicle in violation of the following parking regulations on the Guilford campus:

- Failure to respond to four (4) parking violations summons.
- Parking an unauthorized vehicle in a HANDICAPPED, FIRE LANE, or RESERVED space (including the President's space).
- Parking in the traveled portion of a roadway or in a No Parking/Tow Zone.
- Blocking a dumpster, or otherwise interfering with waste removal.
- Blocking a dumpster, or otherwise interfering with waste removal.

- Faculty/Staff may not park in visitor spaces for any reason.
- Visitor spaces are not to be used by students for any reason.

Commuter Student Parking

- Commuter students may ONLY park in lots or spaces assigned to their permits, including the following lots: Bifford/Hardicks lot, CCE/Northwest lot, North Lot, Dana Auditorium lot, and the lower level by the P.E. Center.

- Visitors spaces are not to be used by students for any reason.
- Faculty and Staff may park in lots or spaces assigned to their permits as well as park in any residential or commuter lot as additional parking.
- Faculty/Staff may not park in visitor spaces for any reason.

Visitor Parking

- Visitor spaces are not to be used by faculty, staff, or students for any reason.
- Frequent or overnight visitors are required to have a temporary parking permit. Students, Faculty, and Staff can obtain these permits in the Public Safety office and are responsible for their guests.
- The row of spaces closest to the New Garden Hall entrance is reserved for guests of the Office of Admission (both traditional and the Center for Continuing Education).

Violations and Fines

- All offenses warrant a fine:

Offense Fine

01 - Parking in Staff area \$20

02 - Parking in reserved space or area \$20

03 - Parking in a non-marked space \$25

04 - Parking on the grass \$25

05 - Blocking another vehicle \$25

06 - Parking in fire lane (towing enforced) \$50

07 - Unregistered vehicle* \$100

08 - Speeding/reckless driving \$100

09 - Parking in handicapped space \$250

10 - Exceeding time limit \$20

11 - Improper display of parking permit \$20

*An unregistered vehicle is any vehicle not displaying a current parking permit, or displaying a permit registered to another vehicle.

General Policies

- Traffic and parking regulations are enforced 24 hours a day throughout the calendar year,** including all breaks, holidays and summer months. These regulations apply whether or not classes are in session.
- All Guilford College employees and students must obtain and properly display a current parking permit for their vehicles parked on the campus during normal business hours in the Office of Public Safety. All students and employees of the College are responsible for obtaining a parking permit and knowing, and adhering to, the policies outlined in this handbook.

- A parking permit DOES NOT guarantee the holder a reserved space, only the opportunity to park within a specified area. Lack of space is NOT a valid excuse for illegal parking.**
- A permit may only be affixed to the vehicle which it is assigned to. Permits are not transferable. A new permit is needed for any change in vehicle or license plates. Failure to do so may result in an unregistered vehicle
