- 2. The non refundable application fee of €25. This fee is payable by cheque or postal order made payable to the National College of Ireland. Please do not send cash. Applications submitted with cash payments will not be accepted. Please note that applications will not be processed without payment of this fee.
- 3. **FOR FULL-TIME COURSES ONLY**, a copy of your birth certificate is required.
- 4. Syllabi for courses if requesting exemptions.
- 5. If you are applying for a postgraduate programme, you must enclose the original transcripts of results from your undergraduate programme.

Please note failure to include this information can result in your application being delayed.
