FINANCING OPTIONS FOR E.U. STUDENTS

You want to study with us but do not know how to finance your studies? Don't worry!

There are many options to choose from ranging from government funding to student loans as well as educational funds!

DEUTSCHLANDSTIPENDIUM

The Deutschlandstipendium programme supports talented and high-achieving students.

Amount: Individuals can receive max. 300 Euro per month

Duration: For at least two semesters but may be provided for a maximum time which covers the standard period of study.

Purpose: To finance the living expenses of students

How it works: - In addition to excellent academic results, the criteria for receiving a scholarship include civic engagement and special personal achievements.

Who can apply?

Applicants must meet the requirements of the individual institutions. In addition to academic achievement, the criteria for selecting scholarship recipients include social commitment and personal achievements, such as a student overcoming challenges or obstacles in his or her social or family background.

KFW STUDENT LOAN



The KfW is a bank that offers financial support for first or second studies in form of a student loan.

Amount: 100 – 650 Euro per month

Duration: Up to 100% of standard study duration

Purpose: To finance the living expenses of students

How it works: A privately funded loan designed to aid students with housing, food and living expenses, granted regardless of personal or parental income and assets, with no collateral required. Flexible repayment period of up to 25 years.

Who can apply?

- » German citizens and their dependents (regardless of nationality) who are living with the German citizen in Germany
- » EU citizens who have been lawfully residing in Germany on a permanent basis for at least three years and their dependents living in Germany
- » So-called educational residents who have a German Higher Education Entrance Qualification

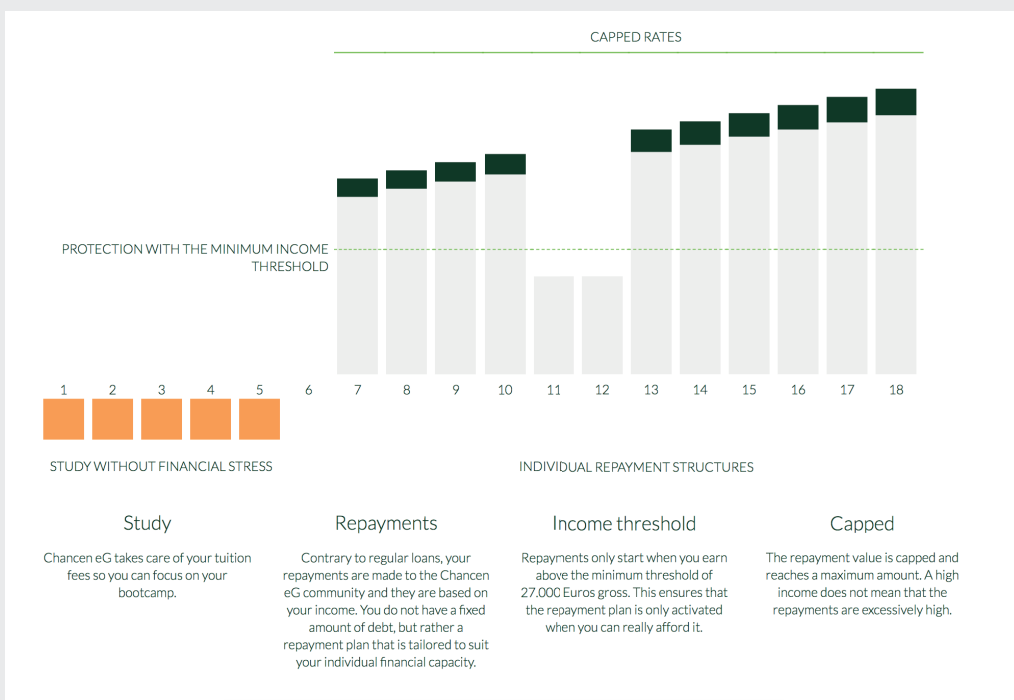

CHANCEN E.G.

Chancen eG is an Income Share Agreement (ISA) that allows students to pay their tuition fees partially or in full only after completing their studies according to a repayment plan.

Amount: Up to 100% of tuition fees (min. 30%)
Duration: Up to 100% of standard study duration
Purpose: Finance a part or the totality of the tuition fees

How it works: Applicants can have their studies financed by Chancen eG partially or in full. At the start of a career and a fixed minimum income, the income-dependent repayment begins. If the income falls below the agreed minimum income, the payment is deferred.

Who can apply?

- » EU citizenship or a permanent residence
- » work permit for the EU
- » Granted admission at SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences

BRAIN CAPITAL

Brain Capital is an education fund that allows students to pay their tuition fees only after completing their studies.

How it works: Applicants can have their entire studies financed by Brain Capital. At the start of a career and a fixed minimum income, the income-dependent repayment begins for a maximum of 10 years. If the income falls below the agreed minimum income, the payment is deferred. After 20 years, the payment ends regardless how much you were able to pay back.

Who can apply?

- » EU citizenship or EU permanent residence
- » Unlimited work and or residence permit within the EU
- » Good school performance (specific conditions may apply depending on the programme)
- » High motivation

HOW IT WORKS

1 SUBMIT APPLICATION

Upon reception of your Letter of Admission, submit your application to studyinberlin@srh.de

2 INTERVIEW

Conduct a personal interview

3 APPROVAL

Once your Education Fund application has been approved, up to 100% of your tuition fees for the standard study period will be covered.

4 REACH YOUR GOALS

Repayments begin when you start your career and earn a fixed minimum income for a maximum of 10 repayment years.
