
I'm proud to say that UCLan has been a major influence in the education sector for over 150 years.

# OUR HISTORY

The University of Central Lancashire (UCLan) in Preston was founded in 1828 as the Institution for the Diffusion of Knowledge. 'Ex solo ad solem', or in translation, 'From the Earth to the Sun', has been its motto ever since – helping people from all walks of life to make the most of their potential is what UCLan's all about.

From state-of-the-art facilities and world class teaching and support to help

our students succeed, to providing world-leading Astrophysics researchers with the opportunity to work with NASA and photograph the Sun, UCLan has it all.

UCLan is a modern university with a strong academic tradition. Whatever your personal reasons for choosing a UK university, we know that you are about to make a life-changing decision. With a student population of 32,000 (3,000 on-campus international students), UCLan is an institution which is a clear favourite among students looking for a UK educational experience.

Amongst its programme portfolio of some 350 undergraduate and almost 200 postgraduate courses, UCLan has been at the forefront of developing degrees in the disciplines of Journalism, Fashion, Forensics

and Sports Science. The range of excellence extends to include the subject areas of Engineering, Architecture, Astrophysics and the new School of Medicine.

A truly global institution, UCLan's student body includes 120 nationalities; its partnership network extends to 125 partnerships in North America, Europe, Africa, Asia and Australasia and offers over 100 student exchange programmes; and it has a new campus in Cyprus. The University encourages and nurtures originality, from its ground-breaking Energy Management partnership with BAE Systems to its proud record of student business start-ups – a sector-leading 60 per cent of which are still thriving after three years.

## TEN FACTS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT UCLAN

### 1

With a student population of around 30,000, UCLan is consistently one of the top ten largest universities in England.

### 2

UCLan has the largest undergraduate research internship scheme of any university in the UK and was a founder member of the British Conference of Undergraduate Research.

### 3

UCLan's sector-leading International Travel Bursary recently enabled over 1,600 undergraduate students to add a global experience to their UCLan education.

### 4

UCLan is the UK's top university for incubating start-up businesses that are still thriving after three years of trading. In the last five years we have helped over 1,000 students or graduates start a business or become self-employed.

In 2015, UCLan welcomed the first cohort of students, from 29 different countries, on to its new self-funded five-year medical programme (MBBS). Aimed at international students, the new MBBS degree will teach medical sciences along with clinical and communication skills out of UCLan's multi-million pound facilities in Preston and Burnley.

Launching in January 2018, the Engineering Innovation Centre (EIC) will place UCLan at the centre of one of the most intense engineering and manufacturing areas in the UK. The EIC will create an integrated space for teaching, research and knowledge exchange.

UCLan is the only UK university to be working in partnership with NASA to capture the highest resolution images ever achieved of the Sun's outer atmosphere.

A revolutionary technique developed by UCLan uses a 3-D printer to 'print' medicinal tablets, enabling medicines to be tailored to an individual patient's needs.

In 2010, UCLan was one of the first modern universities in the UK to successfully enter the QS World University Rankings. QS awarded UCLan a 4-star rating in its 2015 audit.

Situated in the heart of the North West of England, Preston is a vibrant city with a landscape of opportunity at its doorstep.


Preston is located a short distance from the stunning scenery of the Lake District, exciting atmosphere of the seaside, and culture of the big Northern cities.

## Applicants from the European Union (EU)

The closing date for receipt of initial applications by home and EU students is 15 January, for the following September. Your application form should be accompanied by the appropriate fee. Applications received after the UCAS closing date will be considered by us for most courses.
